

ALDRESHOT RESERVE



COMMUNITY FEEDBACK SUMMARY

The key themes raised in consultation that took place have been addressed as follows:

KEY THEMES	FEEDBACK FROM COMMUNITY	HOW THIS HAS BEEN INCLUDED
PLAY	Improving the playground was the most common response in the survey for what the new design should consider.	A major play space upgrade that provides for all age groups has been included as part of the plan.
VEGETATION	More trees and vegetation was a common theme in the consultation, for general amenity, ecological purposes and as windbreak.	The Concept Plan design shows additional trees and garden beds. A detailed plan will provide for improvement of condition of the grass and guidelines on suitable species and installation to maximise the success of plantings. Planting design will be required to allow sightlines between 30cm and 180cm high as per CPTED requirements.
SAFETY	Safety was not raised as a major issue in the CPTED Report or by the majority of people who participated in consultation. However, some issues were identified that impact upon the enjoyment of the reserve by local residents, and the Concept Plan has sought to address these.	The Concept Plan includes provision for implementation of recommendations made by the CPTED Report that directly address the concerns raised by residents (e.g. time-controlled lighting), as well as using CPTED design principles such as clear sight lines.
SPORT AND RECREATION	There was a high level of support for opportunities for unstructured recreation, as opposed to structured sport facilities such as playing fields.	The Concept Plan incorporates elements that encourage people of all ages to be active, including improving the path network and grass areas, and providing high quality fitness equipment/ elements.
BBQ AND PICNIC FACILITIES	Although few people indicated that they currently use the reserve for socialising or BBQs, improvements to the BBQ and picnic area rated reasonably highly in consultation.	The Concept Plan shows upgraded BBQ and picnic facilities (including a toilet that locks automatically outside daylight hours), relocated closer to car parking and access points.
