Nature Faces – Self Portrait

By participating in this competition, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. COMPETITION DETAILS

- 1.1 The promoter of this competition is the Greater Geelong City Council, 30 Gheringhap Street, Geelong VIC 3220, ABN 18 374 210 672 (**City**).
- 1.2 The competition commences at 9:00am on Saturday 23 October 2021 and closes at 5:00pm on Sunday 31 October 2021. Entries will only be accepted during this period.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1 Entry is open to persons under 8 years of age but who have parent or guardian consent to enter and are residents of Victoria.
- 2.2 By entering this competition, you warrant to the City that you are eligible to enter this competition based on these terms and conditions.
- 2.3 Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions. If you do not agree with any part of these terms and conditions you should not enter the competition or accept any prize resulting from entry into the competition.
- 2.4 The City's Family Services staff, their immediate families and those directly involved with this competition are ineligible to enter the prize draw. All other City employees are eligible for this competition.
- 2.5 Entrants should replace the natural elements used after taking the self-portrait photo to the best of their ability.
- 2.6 Entrants should not use natural elements located in areas of Aboriginal cultural significance or areas protected by Vegetation Protection Overlay.
- 2.7 Entrants acknowledge the risk that collecting natural elements for the self-portrait may involve collecting materials from areas that have spiders, ants or other insects and bugs that may injure. Children should be accompanied a parent or guardian when collecting the natural elements.
- 2.8 The amount of entries is unlimited, however only one photograph self-portrait per person will be selected and added to the Nature Faces Quilt.
- 2.9 Photos must be a self-portrait using natural materials and must not contain photos of people.
- 2.10 Images that are considered of an offensive nature will not be accepted.
- 2.11 The City reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process or who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these terms and conditions. Failure by the City to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.

- 2.13 Entries must include your full name, email address and phone number so we can identify your entry and contact the competition winner.
- 2.14 The use of any automated entry software or any other mechanical or electronic means that allows an entrant to automatically enter the competition repeatedly is prohibited and will render all entries submitted by that entrant invalid.
- 2.15 Incomplete, indecipherable or illegible entries will be deemed invalid.
- 2.16 The City of Greater Geelong reserves the right to exhibit and publish all entries within the context of the competition on our website, social media accounts and promotion generally. By entering the competition, entrants authorise City of Greater Geelong to publish any images, both in print and electronically, and to exhibit images. The City of Greater Geelong will also place the images in their image library for ongoing use and promotion of nature play in Geelong

3. PRIZES

- 3.1 One winner will be determined by draw and will receive a Grab it and Go Backpack valued at \$90.
- 3.2 The City will deliver the prize to the winner/winners nominated address within 28 days of the draw.
- 3.3 The prize is not transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash.
- 3.4 Unless otherwise stated, all costs incurred by a winner to accept or use the prize are the responsibility of the winner.

4. PRIZE DRAW

- 4.1 The prize draw will take place at the City's office at Gheringhap Street on 26 November 2021.
- 4.2 The method of drawing will be as follows:

The Deputy Geelong Mayor will select and shortlist their favourite twenty (20) photos after the close of the Entry Period, selection will be based on individuality, authenticity and connection to nature. The photos will be uploaded to the Children's Week Have Your Say page for public vote https://yoursay.geelongaustralia.com.au/gew

- 4.2.1 The photo with the most community votes at the close of the competition on 25 November, 2021 will be selected as the winner.
- 4.3 The Deputy Geelong Mayor's decision to shortlist a photo is final. The shortlisted candidates will be notified by email and recognised on the Have Your Say page and the City of Greater Geelong social media channels at random and each entrant will have an equal chance of being drawn.
- 4.1 The prize winner will be notified in writing by 3 December 2021 via email.
- 4.2 A prize will be deemed unclaimed if the City, despite using reasonable efforts, is not able to deliver the prize to the winner in accordance with condition 4.4.
- 4.3 If you are the winner of a prize, you consent to the City using your name in any media for the purpose of publishing the outcome of this competition.
